

The following is a sample from the upper elementary Adventures to Knighthood:

Week 6: Become a squire and learn about chivalry

Monday: Read "Robert the Squire," from Knights & Castles, pages 20-21.

Suggested topics for discussion/journaling:

What would be the most difficult aspect of being a squire? Why? What would be your favorite part of being a squire? Why?

Tuesday: Read "Knights & Chivalry," from Castles, pages 56-57 and explore links. Print out the maze and rescue Sir Crispin.

Suggested topics for discussion/journaling:

How could you be chivalrous to your parents? To your siblings? To your friends?

Wednesday: Read "Chivalry," from Knights, pages 32-33 and explore links.

Suggested topics for discussion/journaling:

What is considered chivalrous today? Keep an eye out for people being chivalrous. Do something chivalrous for 5 strangers in the next week.

Thursday: Learn about who lives in the castle. Read "Who's who: at the top" and "Who's who: servants," from Castles, pages 64-65 and 70-71 and explore links. Design a seal to represent you once you become a knight.

Friday: Read "All Wrapped up," from Castles, pages 42-43. Plan and draw the suit of armor you will get when you become a knight.
